Trips to Perfect North, Timberline and Snowshoe

Winter has arrived and everyone will be thinking about skiing opportunities!

Local resorts will be welcoming skiers and snowboarders very soon. Perfect North has made improvements to their snowmaking infrastructure. Watch for the opening day on their website. Snowshoe will be celebrating their 50th anniversary this season and will open Dec 4. Timberline Mountain is scheduled to open Dec 5. We have several trips to offer this season. Transportation is by personal vehicle or carpooling.

Perfect North: January 5

We'll meet at 8:00 am in the parking lot of Mariott Griffin Gate Hotel (end closest to the Marathon gas station) for those wanting to meet for carpooling.

Timberline Mountain: January 26 - 28 or 29

Our first trip to Timberline has an option of skiing 2 - 3 1/2 days. Just a few miles away is a separate ski area at Canaan Valley Resort State Park. Lodging options include Canaan Valley Resort at the Park or Timberline Hotel (slopeside) offering mid-week prices. Both are hotel rooms with a mini fridge and microwave. There may be an opportunity to stay at a condo slope-side depending on availability and number of sign-ups for the January trip only. Please notify Robin of your interest prior to making reservations.

Timberline Mountain: February 7 - 9

The second trip to Timberline will be the weekend of Feb 7-9 and early hotel reservations are encouraged.

Snowshoe Mountain: February 9 - 12

For the members who want to combine 2 trips, it is a 2-hour drive from Timberline to Snowshoe. Snowshoe is an IKON Pass resort. For those without the IKON Pass, <u>Snowshoe is offering a 3-day FLEX Pass for \$199</u> for a limited time only. The resort has a free shuttle to get around the mountain day and night. We will stay in condos on the mountain. The estimated cost will range from \$400 to \$460 per person depending on the total number of participants and bedding configuration.

Finland And Switzerland

Sunday, February 2, 2025 to Friday, February 14, 2025
In Search of the Northern Lights with post trip to Switzerland



In Finland, you can view nature's most spectacular light show, the Aurora Borealis, from purpose-built spaces like glass huts and luxury suites.

The Northern Lights are visible roughly 200 nights a year in Finnish Lapland? While many choose to go Aurora-spotting by snowshoe, ski, snowmobile or dog sled, you can also view the Northern Lights from the comfort of the indoors.

The nights are typically dark enough to see the Northern Lights from late August to April – all you need are clear skies and a bit of luck. Head north for the best chance of catching them.

Known as one of the cradles of skiing, the winter sports that we see today stem from the Jungfrau ski region. Wengen, for example, has been hosting ski races for over 100 years. The name of the region comes from the magnificent Jungfrau Mountain, the largest peak between itself and its neighbors: the Eiger and the Mönch. One of the major attractions to the ski region is the amazing off-piste area its slopes provide.

Jungfrau has three areas in one: Grindelwald-Wengen, Grindelwald-First and Mürren-Schilthorn. Altogether, the region consists of two valleys, three mountain ranges and 131 miles of skiable terrain. There's something for every level of skier, from gentle to steep slopes, plenty of powder, terrain parks and racing areas.
